



## **HOW TO:**

**Modify bt-WebFilter 4 Redirect Page**

**Display Language**



You can modify the language used to display the “Categorization” variable within the code outlined at the end of this guide. In addition, the variable can be used to any text you wish to display to the users.

The steps outlined in this guide will require you to be familiar with your Web Server configuration and know where your root directory is located.

1. Copy the code at the end of this document and paste the contents into the web editor of your choice.
2. Locate the following section:

‘Do the category renaming here:

    If value = “XXX” Then

        Value = “YYY”

    End If

3. Modify the “If value = “XXX” Then” section to the preferred URL Control List category.

    Example:        “If value = “Email” Then

4. Modify the “value = “YYY”” line to the desired text to display.

    Example:        “value = “Restricted Content”

The example above will now produce an output as follows when the user attempts to visit a website in the E-mail category of the control list:

“You have requested “URL Here”

Access to the requested web page is denied using Burst Technology Filtering Software.

The Requested web page is categorized as Restricted Content

If you think this is in error, please contact your system administrator.

5. Save the document as an .aspx file and place it in the appropriate directory on the Web Server.
  - Note: You can create multiple “If value” lines for displaying custom messages per category as in the following code example:

```
'Do the category renaming here:  
  If value = "Email" Then  
    value = "Restricted Content"  
  End If  
  If value = "Games" Then  
    value = "Not During working Hours"  
  End If
```



- 6. In the bt-WebFilter Management Console, select the "Custom Access Policies" category. (See Figure 1)

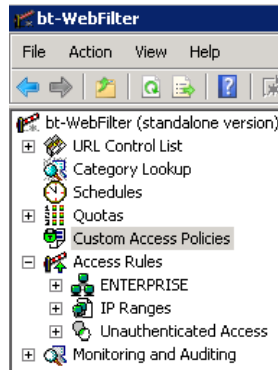

- 7. On the right side of the screen, select the policy that you wish to apply the new redirect page to.

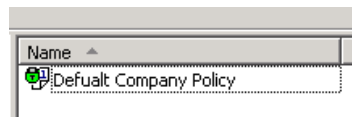

- 8. In the "Redirect URL:" box, type full URL to the new redirect page you created then click "Apply" then "OK".

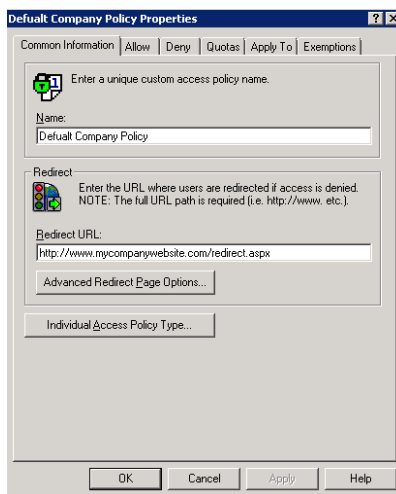

- 9. Test the new redirect page against a known categorized URL and verify that the displayed text is as desired.

  Case 6
    sReason = "Quota on <font color=" &#xFF0000" & Server.HtmlEncode( value ) & "</FONT> Web area has been exceeded."
  Case 7
    sReason = "Quota on <font color=" &#xFF0000" & Server.HtmlEncode( value ) & "</FONT> category has been exceeded."
